... here we GROW!

Musica! class provides students in grades 2nd-6th with the opportunity to be exposed to the foundations of music through a general music class.

Just as a visual artist might have several mediums to use, our Musica! students will have the opportunity to try different types of instruments and music-making in this very hands-on class. Students' learning experiences will include physical movement activities, singing, listening, and introduction to symbols of music notation.

Students will begin to learn the basic elements of music - rhythm, melody, and harmony.

Three specific vehicles of instruction will be utilized:

- Orff instruments (glockenspiels & xylophones)
- Nuvo instruments (beginner innovative wind instruments that are modeled on formal band instruments) & floor percussion (toms and gathering drums)
- Choral activities (Curwen hand signs for Solfeggio, folk songs & partner songs, "sound before sight" singing, TaKaDiMi rhythms, and proper vocal technique for the young voice)

This will be taught by a steady team of music instructors, depending on the aspect of music that the students are learning. [Our new staff member Maureen Anderson will be the lead teacher. We're so excited about Mrs. Anderson joining Overture!](#)

After a year of Musica! class, students will be prepared to pursue learning a band instrument, joining a choral ensemble, or both!
